

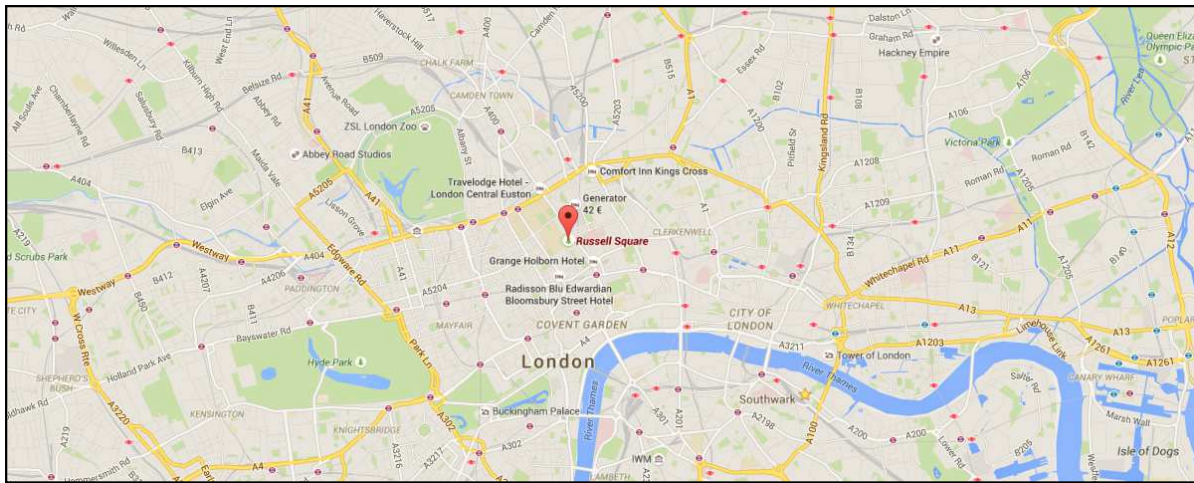

This congress will take place in School of Oriental & African Studies, University of London (Russell Square, London, WC1H 0XG), on Saturday 17th October 2015 from 9:15 am to 7 pm.
